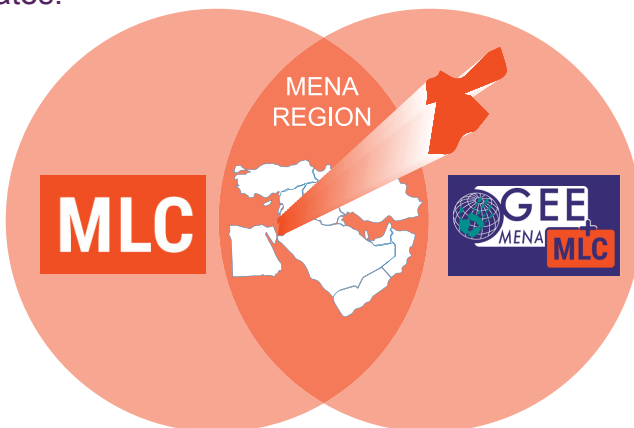
ABOUT GEE-MLC

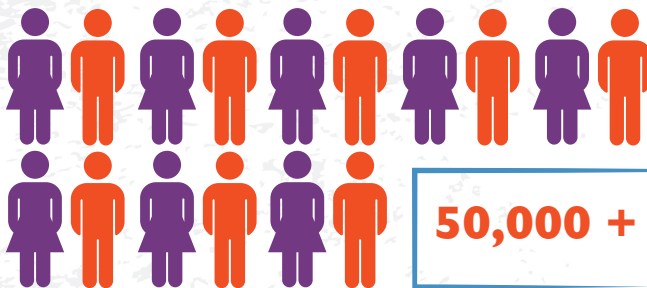
- All online **ESL instructors** are native English speakers living in the United States.

What is an ESL program?

An ESL program is coursework designed to help students who are looking to learn English as their second, third, or in some cases, fourth language.

These programs hire teachers to help students develop their:

- Speaking
- Writing
- Reading
- Listening skills.

Students can begin studies at one of our partner universities after successfully completing ESL studies at Michigan Language Center (MLC) and meeting the university's English requirements.

OR

Receive MLC English Proficiency Recommendation

Follow these steps:

1. complete advanced (level 5) classes with minimum 85% average

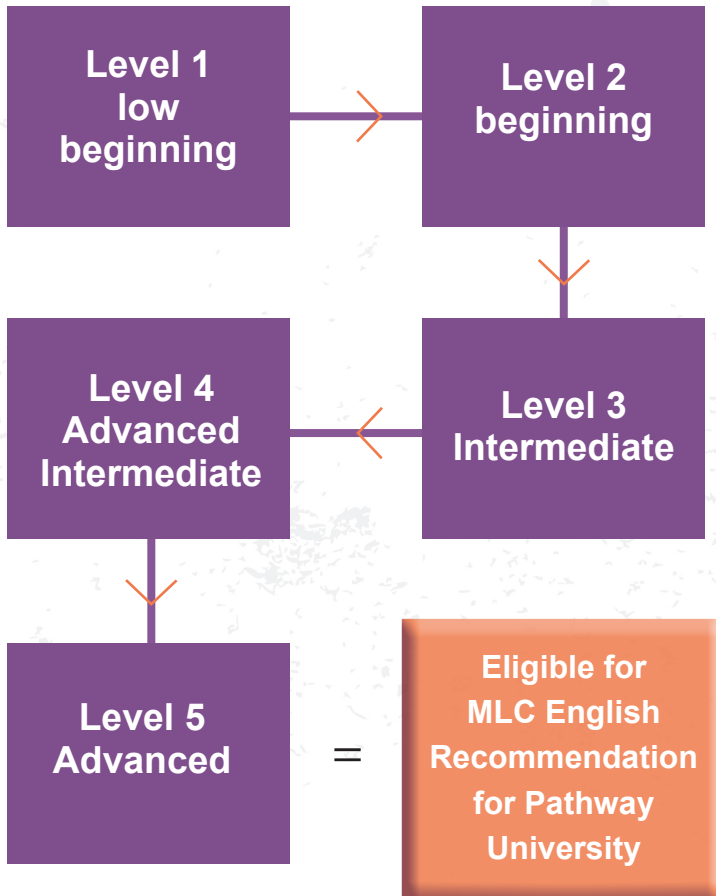
2. Pass speaking interview

3. Pass writing exam

* If necessary, pass Grammar, Vocabulary and Reading skills test

GEE-MLC Progression of Levels

**** A student will be placed in one of the following 5 levels**



* Each level requirement: Students must complete 4 sessions with 85% average in order to advance to the next level.

* One Session = 4 Weeks

* Some students may progress more quickly

University Pathway

Students can meet the English language condition for undergraduate admissions by passing the Advanced level at Michigan Language Center at the following Universities.

(Note: we are counting to expand this list of universities)

Intensive English Program Ann Arbor

MLC Ann Arbor Campus offers in-person English classes to improve reading, writing, speaking, pronunciation, and listening skills in the following categories:

- *Intensive English Program (All 5 Levels)*
- *TOEFL & IELTS test prep*
- *Workplace conversation, presentation, reading and writing*
- *Everyday English conversation, reading and writing*
- *Meet conditional admissions requirements for a partner university*

Tuition covers not just the English classes, but also books and materials, co-curricular clubs for additional English practice, university counseling, conversation partner program, and more.

5-Week Full-Time Comprehensive Tuition: \$1475 USD

Note: Students who come to MLC Ann Arbor with an F-1 international student visa must enroll in the Intensive English Program and study full time (20 hours per week).

HOW TO APPLY

GEE-MLC Application Process

1. Take our free online English Placement Test
2. Schedule a free online Assessment Meeting
3. Complete Online Enrollment Form (email will be sent to applicant)
4. Pay for classes

MLC I-20 Application Process

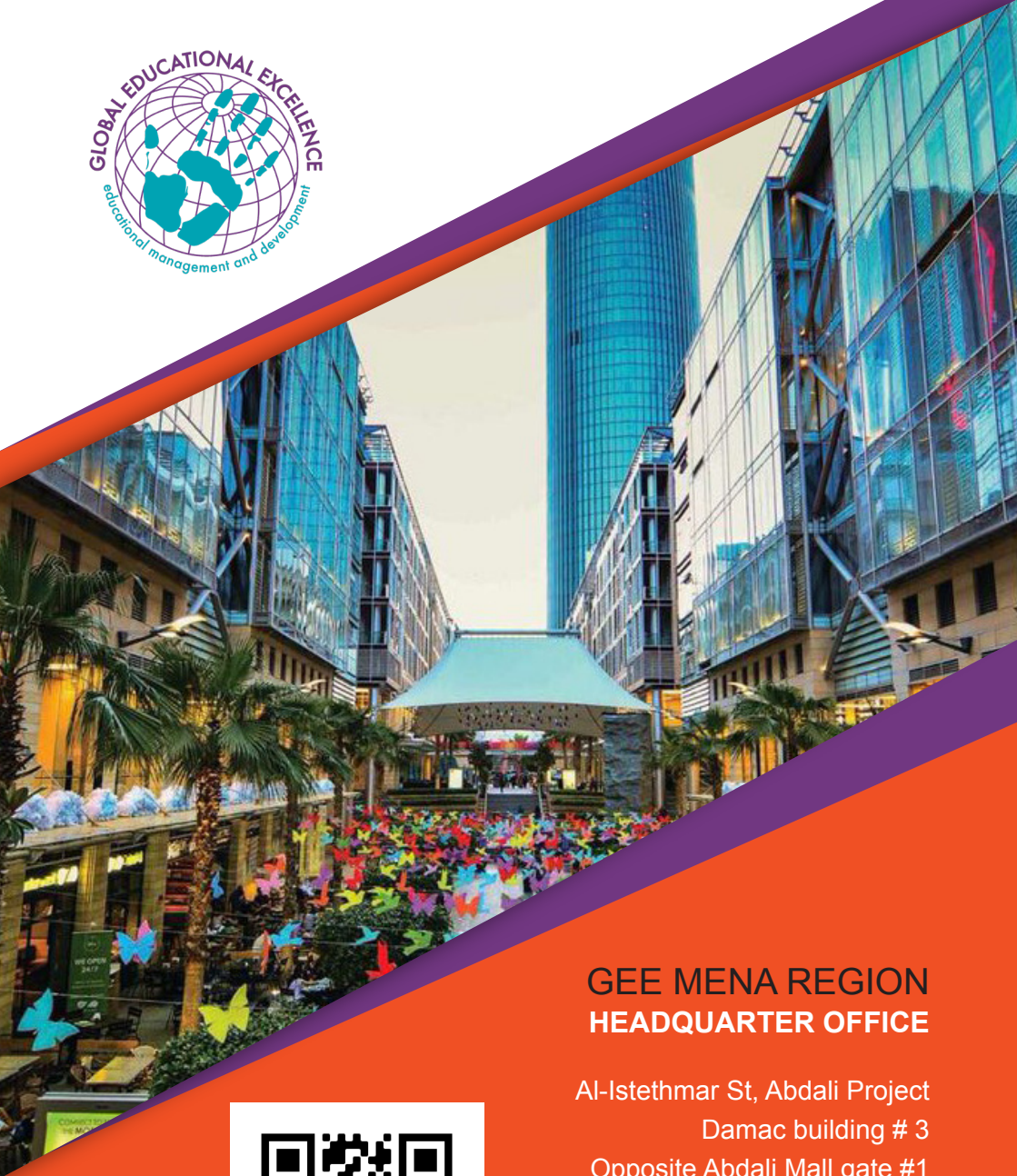
1. Apply for an I-20 by filling out the application form
2. Submit a copy of the applicant's passport and financial documents
3. Students need to pay a **non-refundable \$100 application fee**
4. After the applicant receives our I-20, they will have to schedule a visa appointment and apply for the F-1 visa to come to the U.S.

5. Once the applicant has successfully received the F-1 visa, we will send them additional instructions to take our English Placement Test to determine their English level and class schedule
6. All F-1 international students are required to study full-time (20 hours per session).
7. Tuition will be due by the Registration Deadline.
